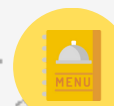

Education Services



• **Consumer Price Index (CPI)**

an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year

• **Inflation Rate (IR)**

annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent

• **Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP)**

shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period

• Starting 2022, the base year for the CPI was rebased to 2018.

• For the rebased series, two new commodity groups were added, namely, (XII) Financial Services, and (XIII) Personal Care, and Miscellaneous Goods and Services
