**ENJOINING ALL STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCs)
IN CENTRAL VISAYAS TO SUPPORT THE CAPACITY BUILDING
PROGRAM RELATED TO COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING
SYSTEM (CBMS)**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11315 otherwise known as the “Community-Based Monitoring System Act” was signed into law on 17 April 2019;

WHEREAS, the CBMS refers to an organized technology-based system of collecting, processing and validating necessary disaggregated data that may be used for policy formulation, planning, program and project implementation and monitoring at the local level while empowering communities to participate in the process;

WHEREAS, it involves the generation of data at the local level which serves as basis in targeting households in the planning, budgeting, and implementation of government programs geared towards poverty alleviation and socio-economic development;

WHEREAS, the city or municipal statistician is responsible for data collection, processing, mapping and geo-tagging, database management and ensure the dissemination of CBMS data to internal users;

WHEREAS, the city or municipal statistician needs to be capacitated in the collection, processing, analysis and presentation of CBMS data at the local level;

WHEREAS, the committee sees the potential of SUCs in the region to be the institutional partner in capability building program for the local government units;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enjoin the State Universities and Colleges in Central Visayas to support the capacity building program related to the community-based monitoring system;
