RSC Resolution No. 1 (s. 2016)

EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICS COMMITTEE TO INCLUDE THE CITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICES (CPDOs) OF LAPU-LAPU AND MANDAUE

WHEREAS, Regional Statistics Committees (RSCs) were established in the regions by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Board to provide direction and guidance to regional and local statistical development activities;

WHEREAS, the RSCs serve as a link between the PSA and the Local Government Units (LGUs) on statistical matters, and as a coordinating mechanism for statistical activities planned and implemented by LGUs;

WHEREAS, to strengthen coordination between and among the PSA, RSC and LGUs, and since the RSC can modify its composition and expand its membership, the RSC, in its meeting on 2 February 2016, deemed it beneficial to expand its membership to include the City Planning and Development Offices (CPDOs) of Lapu-Lapu City and Mandaue City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to expand the membership of the Regional Statistics Committee to include the City Planning and Development Offices of Lapu-Lapu and Mandaue.
