

RSC Resolution No. 3 (s. 2017)

REQUESTING ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC AGENCIES TO SUPPORT IN THE CONDUCT OF PILOT QUATERLY FAMILY INCOME AND EXPENDITURE SURVEY (FIES) AND ANNUAL POVERTY INDICATOR SURVEY (APIS)

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority is mandated to promote the orderly development of a statistical system capable of providing timely, accurate and useful data for the government and the public;

WHEREAS, FIES and APIS are nationwide undertaking conducted by the Philippine Statistics Authority by virtue of Republic Act (RA) 10625;

WHEREAS, FIES is a sample survey designed to provide family income and expenditure data, which include among others, levels of consumption by item of expenditure as well as sources of income in cash and in kind;

WHEREAS, APIS is designed to provide income and non-income indicator related to poverty, specifically, data on socio-economic profile of families and other information related to their living condition;

WHEREAS, the PSA sees the need of the support of the private and public agencies in the successful undertaking of the above-mentioned surveys;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the committee is requesting for the support of all private and public agencies in the conduct of Pilot Quarterly Family Income and Expenditure Survey and Annual Poverty Indicator Survey.
