RSC Resolution No. 5 (s. 2016)

ADOPTING THE CENTRAL VISAYAS CORE REGIONAL INDICATORS (CORE-IS) AND REQUESTING PSA BOARD APPROVAL OF THE SAME

WHEREAS, Statistics plays a significant contribution in the socio-economic development of the country;

WHEREAS, because of the need for statistical data and information, the Philippine Statistics Authority developed the CoRe-Is and will maintain a regional statistical bank:

WHEREAS, the CoRe-Is is a compilation of statistical data and administrative-based data from various government agencies, designed to provide stakeholders with readily available set of statistics to be used in monitoring plans and programs, and in tracking progress over time;

WHEREAS, the proposed CoRe-Is was presented and discussed with officials and staff of NEDA VII and the members of RSC VII;

WHEREAS, the CoRe-Is would be beneficial in the preparation of the Development Plans of various government agencies, councils and committees, and in project development and research by both the government and private sectors;

WHEREAS, the additional indicators proposed by RSC Region VII will be included and added to the existing indicators of the CoRe-Is;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to adopt the Central Visayas CoRe-Is and to request for its approval by the PSA Board.
