## RSC Resolution No. 8 Series of 2020

## REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY TO INCLUDE CENTRAL VISAYAS AS ONE OF THE PILOT AREAS FOR THE COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM(CBMS)

WHEREAS, Republic Act 11315 also known as the "Community-Based Monitoring System Act was signed into law on 17 April 2020;

WHEREAS, one of the objectives of CBMS is to establish a data collection, data sharing and information management system which shall respect the fundamental human right to privacy, ensure data quality, and uphold data protection principles of legitimation purpose, transparency, and proportionality;

WHEREAS, the Central Visayas RSC seeks to improve the region's economic environment as the CBMS will aid the local planners and local chief executives in the region in providing the appropriate data sources;

WHEREAS, Central Visayas RSC expressed its full support in the implementation of the CBMS in the region and to maximize the participation of the LGUs;

WHEREAS, the RSC sees the importance of having the region included in the pilot testing of CBMS as this will prepare the pilot city/municipality in the region for the full implementation of the CBMS;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the Philippine Statistics Authority to include Central Visayas as one of the pilot areas for the Community-Based Monitoring System; and
