Game Mechanics: PSA Says

Contest Description: The PSA Says is patterned after the popular game show Family Feud, in which two (2) teams compete to guess the most popular responses to survey questions. The trivia questions for this game were based on the results of the censuses and surveys, and other statistics generated by the Philippine Statistics Authority. The game aims to test data awareness among students.

Contestants: Students from various higher education institutions in Western Visayas (Region VI), Central Visayas (Region VII), and Eastern Visayas (Region VIII) who registered as participants in the Regional Data Festival Visayas Cluster can participate in the game. Four (4) teams composed of five (5) members will be randomly identified upon registration at the venue through draw lots.

Game Mechanics:

1. Four (4) Teams with five (5) members will compete in the game. The first two (2) teams will compete in the first match. Each team shall designate a team captain who will act as the decision-maker. The captain of each team will be the one to answer the first question. Each player will have 10 seconds to answer the question.
2. A statistics trivia will be given to the participants before the question.
3. The team who pressed the game buzzer first will have the chance to answer the question.
4. The team that buzzed in with an answer with higher points gets control of the board and has the option of playing and passing control to the other team.
5. The team in control remains in the position if it reveals all the correct answers to the question without giving three wrong answers.
6. If the controlling team gives three (3) wrong answers or fail to give an answer within the allotted time, the other team will have the chance to steal and control the game. The new controlling team must provide an answer found on the board within 5 seconds. Corresponding points will be added to the team's score for every correct answer given.
7. If the next team in control gives a wrong answer or a correct one that has been previously given or fails to answer within 5 seconds, the opposing team will earn all the accumulated points for the question.
8. The game assigns a single point value for the first three (3) questions, which is doubled in the fourth question and tripled in the fifth question.
9. The team with the most points wins.
10. The remaining two (2) teams will compete in the second match. The winning team will then compete with the winner of the first match.
11. The overall winning team will be determined by their total points in the last or third match.
12. Players for this game are prohibited from using smartphones during the game. Violation will result in disqualification for the team.
