LCRO-Lazi, Siquijor commemorates February 23 as “National Birth Registration Day”

Philippine Statistics Authority, Siquijor Provincial Statistical Office participated and assisted in the mobile registration activity conducted by the LCRO of Lazi headed by MCR Lee Hines L. Largo. This is one of the highlights of LCRO, Lazi in celebration of the month-long celebration of the 31st Civil Registration Month.

It is a continuing thrust to continually serve and assist the public regarding their concerns on Civil Registration particularly constituents coming from the Municipality of Lazi.

In support to this activity, Mayor James D. Monte issued Executive Order (EO) No. 6, to this effect. EO No 6, titled as “Commemorating February 23, 2021 as National Birth Registration Day in the Municipality of Lazi, Siquijor highlighting the conduct of free issuance of Affidavit of Two Disinterested Persons prepared and subscribed by the MCR for the purpose of Late Registration of births. This is a one-day free late registration of births in the Municipality of Lazi.


The activity tallied a total of seven (7) late registrations of births free of charges from the LGUs fees, in which the documents submitted for this kind of process were scrutinized and checked for its completeness as per supporting documents attached.


