PSA Siquijor holds a Lecture on "The Importance of Emotional Wellness in the Midst of Adversity"



The Philippine Statistics Authority, Siquijor Provincial Statistical Office (PSO) in collaboration with the Philippine Mental Health Association, Dumaguete Chapter held a lecture entitled "The Importance of Emotional Wellness in the Midst of Adversity" on 16 November 2021 via face-to-face and virtual platforms. In attendance were the regular employees and contract of service workers (COSW) of Siquijor PSO together with the Statistical Researchers of the Agricultural Statistics Surveys. The lecture aimed to understand mental health and its importance to one's life, determine how stress affects one's overall well-being and provide tips on how to take care of one's mental well-being.

In his welcome remarks, Supervising Statistical Specialist Joselito C. Maghanoy extended a warm greeting to all those in attendance, both physically and virtually. He expressed his gratitude to the resource speaker for taking time out of her busy schedule. Moreover, Registration Officer II Rizalyn Teodora G.
