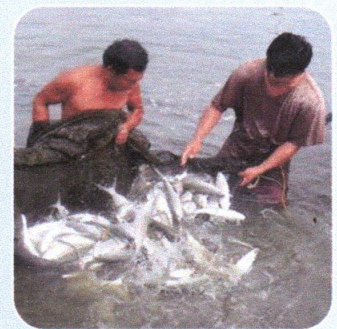
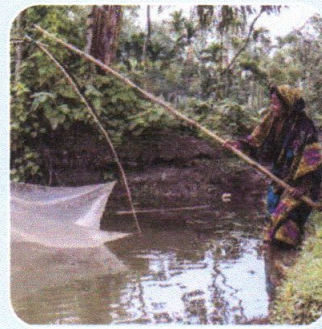
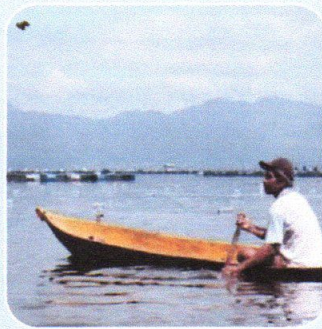


FISHERIES PRODUCTION in Negros Oriental

FISHERIES PRODUCTION – The fisheries sector engaged in the production, growing, harvesting, processing, marketing, developing, conserving and managing of aquatic resources and fishing areas. All activities relating to the act or business of fishing, culturing, preserving, processing, marketing, developing, conserving and managing aquatic resources and the fishery areas including the privilege to fish or take aquatic resources thereof (RA 8550) is known as fisheries.



COMMERCIAL FISHERIES has a production of 392.57 metric tons. This is equivalent to PHP45625.03 thousand pesos.

YELLOWFIN TUNA (Tambako/ Bariles) has the largest volume of fish unloading with 104.30 metric tons in commercial fisheries which is valued at PHP18,482.20 thousand pesos.

MARINE MUNICIPAL FISHERIES has an output of 1,433.52 metric tons. This is valued at PHP142,274.80 thousand pesos.

BIG-EYED SCAD (Matangbaka) has 219.78 metric tons unloading in marine municipal fisheries with a value of PHP24,063.71 thousand pesos.

INLAND MUNICIPAL FISHERIES has a production of 2.14 metric tons.

MUD CRAB (Alimango) catch in inland municipal fisheries recorded 0.69 metric tons with a value of PHP98.15 thousand pesos.



AQUACULTURE has a harvest of 605.71 metric tons which amounted to PHP101,516.25 thousand pesos.

MILKFISH (Bangus) has the largest harvest with 164.61 metric tons and is valued at PHP17,334.00 thousand pesos.

BRACKISH WATER FISHPOND harvested 432.86 metric tons with a value of PHP101,516.25 thousand pesos.
