

First Semester 2018 Poverty Statistics of Central Visayas (Preliminary Results)



Republic Act 8425 of 1997 (Social Reform & Poverty Alleviation Act)

defines "Poor as individuals and families whose income fall below the poverty threshold as defined by the NEDA and/or cannot afford in a sustained manner to provide their minimum basic needs of food, health, education, housing and other essential amenities of life." (Section 3 of the RA 8425)

POVERTY THRESHOLD



On average, the monthly income to meet the basic food and nonfood needs with a family of five members in Central Visayas is

out of 100 Families in Central Visayas did not have sufficient income to meet their basic food and non-food needs in the first half of 2018

Poverty Threshold is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food and non-food requirements, also known as the POVERTY LINE.

out of 100 Families in Central Visayas did not have sufficient income to meet their basic food needs in the first half of 2018


Food Threshold is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food needs, which satisfies the nutritional requirements for economically necessary and socially desirable physical activities.
