

SUGARCANE

2,443,676

a perennial tropical grass with tall stout jointed stems from which sugar is extracted.



COCONUT (WITH HUSK)

445,358 metric tons the large, oval, brown seed of a tropical palm, consisting of a hard shell lined with edible white flesh and containing a clear liquid.



BANANA

207,959

a long curved fruit which grows in clusters and has soft pulpy flesh and yellow skin when ripe.



MANGO

73,545

a fleshy, oval, yellowish-red tropical fruit that is eaten ripe or used green for pickles or chutneys.



CASSAVA

66,237 metric tons starchy tuberous root of a tropical tree, used as food in tropical countries but requiring careful preparation to remove traces of cyanide from the flesh
