What is CPI?

The **Consumer Price Index (CPI)** is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Other Indicators Computed from the CPI:

- **Inflation Rate (IR)**
annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent
- **Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP)**
shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period
