## What Poverty Statistics does PSA produce?

- **POVERTY THRESHOLD**

the minimum income/expenditure required for a family/individual to meet the basic food and non-food requirements

- **POVERTY INCIDENCE**

the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita poverty threshold to the total number of families/individuals

- **FOOD THRESHOLD**

the minimum income/expenditure required for a family/individual to meet the basic food needs, which satisfies the nutritional requirements for economically necessary and socially desirable physical activities

- **SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE**

the proportion of families/individuals with per capita income/expenditure less than the per capita food threshold to the total number of families/individuals

## POVERTY THRESHOLD

In Bohol, a family of five members needed



**Php 12,613**

on the average monthly to meet their basic food and non-food needs during the first semester of 2018.

## FOOD THRESHOLD

On the other hand, a family of five members needed



**Php 8,796**

on the average monthly to meet their basic food needs during the first semester of 2018.

## POVERTY INCIDENCE



**2 in every 10 families**

did not meet their basic food and non-food needs in the first semester of 2018.

**26.0 %**

of Boholanos cannot afford to meet their basic food and non-food needs. This is 5% lower than that of 2015.

## SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE

**8 in every 100 families**

did not have sufficient income to meet their basic food needs during the first semester of 2018.

**10.3 %**

of individuals cannot afford their basic food needs in the first semester of 2018. This decreased by 2.9 from 13.2 in 2015.
