

HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS of NEGROS ORIENTAL

Based on POPCEN 2015

There are **307,894** occupied housing units in Negros Oriental in 2015.



About **9.25** percent higher than in 2010 with **281,826** occupied housing units.

There were **101 households** per 100 occupied housing units. Majority of the occupied housing units were single houses.

66.4 percent (204,437 households) of the occupied housing units had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum

55.5 percent (172,389 households) lived in lots that they owned or amortized

40.5 percent (124,657 households) of the occupied housing units had outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa

37.0 percent 115,052 households use own faucet community water system for cooking

25.9 percent (80,342 households) reported that own use faucet community water system was their source of water supply for drinking

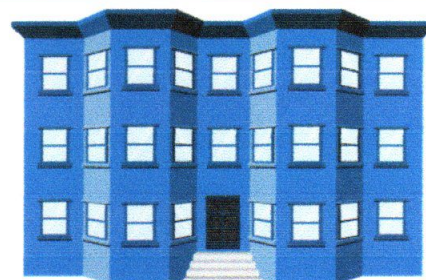
65.0 percent (201,800 households) used electricity as fuel for lighting
