

PALAY and CORN Production of Negros Oriental

July to September 2021

Palay production in the third quarter of 2021 grew by 8.4 percent from the 9.6 thousand metric tons in 2020 to 10.4 thousand metric tons in 2021.

Irrigated Palay harvested 9.3 thousand metric tons in 2021 while Rainfed Palay harvested 1.1 thousand metric tons.

Crop production refers to quantity produced and actually harvested during the reference period. It includes those harvested but damaged, stolen, given away, consumed, given as harvesters' and threshers' shares, reserved, etc. Palay and corn production from seed growers which are intended for seed purposes is excluded from the production.

On the contrary, Corn production dropped by 14.8 percent compared last year from 27.2 thousand metric tons in 2020 to 23.1 thousand metric tons in 2021.

White corn harvested 22.8 thousand metric tons in 2021 while Yellow Corn harvested 0.3 thousand metric tons.

Total area harvested in palay for the quarter reached 10,390 hectares. About 9,272 hectares were from irrigated palay while 1,118 hectares were from rainfed palay.

Out of the 23,131 hectares harvested in corn, 22,836 hectares were white corn areas and 295 hectares were yellow corn areas.
