#### Republic Act 8425 of 1997 (Social Reform & Poverty Alleviation Act)

defines POOR as "individuals and families whose income fall below the poverty thresholds defined by the NEDA and/or cannot afford in a sustained manner to provider their minimum basic needs of food, health, education, housing and other essential amenities of life" (Section 3 of the RA 8425)

#### POVERTY THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food and non-food requirements, also known as the POVERTY LINE.

#### **POVERTY INCIDENCE**

Is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Poverty Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.
