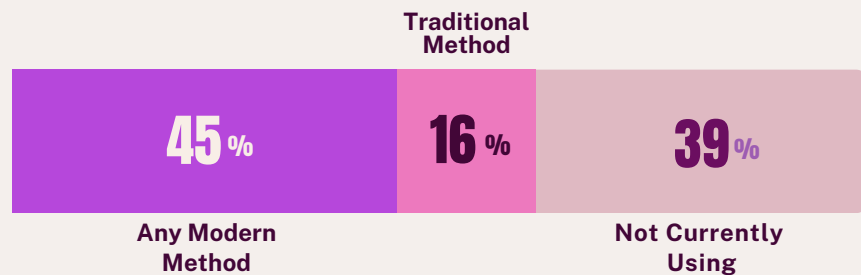
## NATIONAL DEMOGRAPHIC AND HEALTH SURVEY

The 2022 Philippine National Demographic and Health Survey (NDHS) is the seventh Demographic and Health Survey (DHS) conducted in the Philippines in collaboration with the worldwide Demographic and Health Surveys Program, and the 12th in a series of national DHS conducted every five years since 1968. The 2022 NDHS was implemented by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA). The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) provided technical assistance through ICF under the DHS Program.

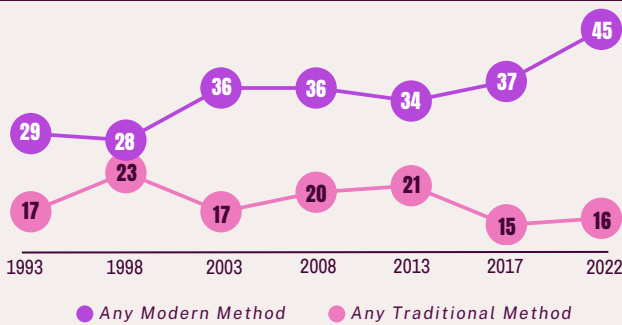


### CURRENT CONTRACEPTIVE USE

(Currently **married** women age 15–49)



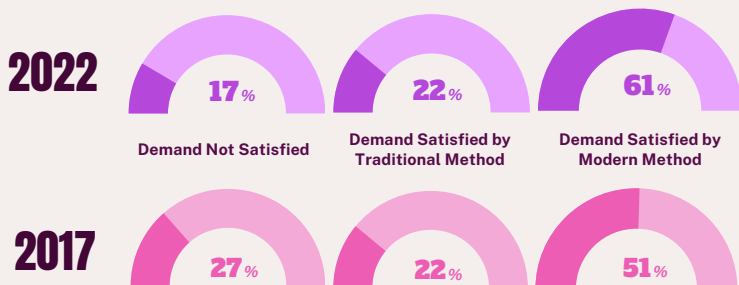
### TRENDS IN CONTRACEPTIVE USE (in percent)



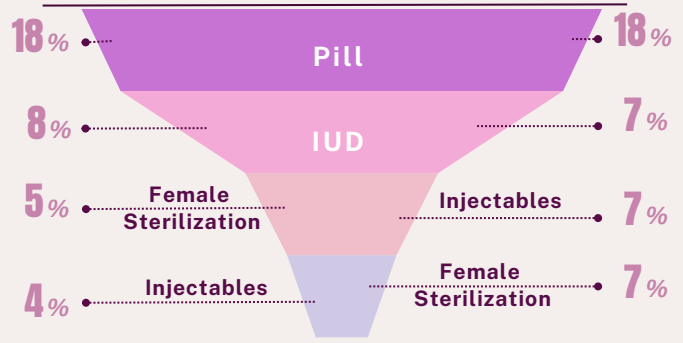
Married women's use of modern methods of family planning has steadily increased over the last 3 decades, from 29 percent of married women in 1993 to 45 percent in 2022. Married women's use of traditional methods of family planning has remained relatively stable with 16 percent of married women using traditional methods of family planning in 2022.

Percent distribution of currently married women age 15-49 years with need for family planning



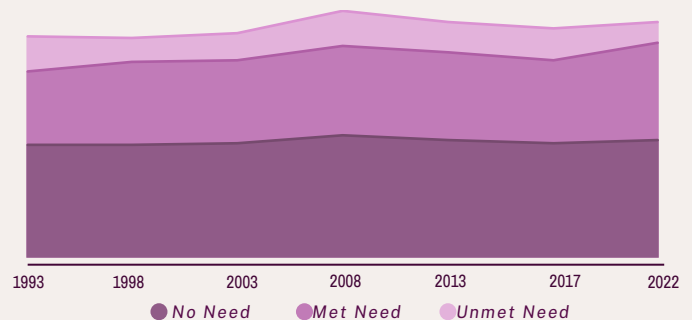

Met Need among currently married women have increased steadily over time, from 46 percent in 1993 to 61 percent in 2022. On the other hand, unmet need for currently married women decreased from 22 percent in 1993 to 13 percent in 2022.
