## INFLATION RATE FOR ALL INCOME HOUSEHOLDS, FEBRUARY 2025 (2018=100)

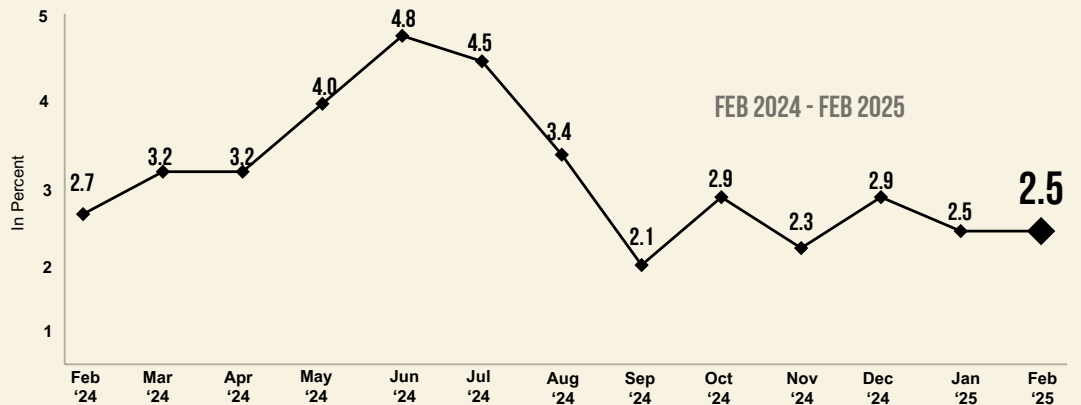

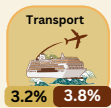

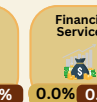
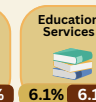
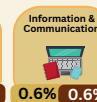
#### Higher Inflation Rates



#### Lower Inflation Rates



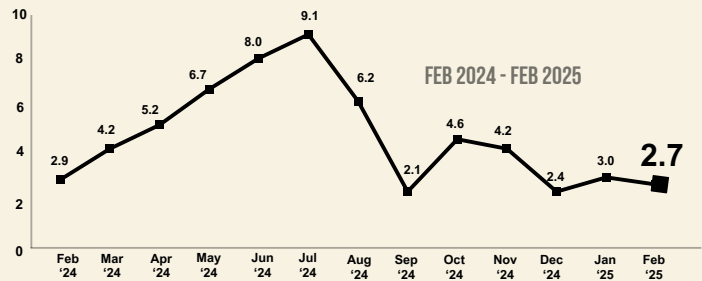
#### Retained Inflation Rates
