## OUTSTANDING MILESTONE IN NATIONAL ID REGISTRATIONS FOR NEGROS ORIENTAL

We are thrilled to share remarkable news about the National ID registration efforts in Negros Oriental. As of the latest update, a total of 1,249,177 registrations have been completed, reflecting 87.26% of the total population based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (CPH). This impressive figure places Negros Oriental 13th in the nationwide ranking for National ID registrations.

But that's not all! We've exceeded our first-semester target by achieving 101.07% of the goal. The target was set at 1,235,950 registrations, and we've successfully registered 1,249,177 individuals, showcasing our commitment and efficiency. This achievement ranks us 7th nationwide for surpassing registration targets.

Additionally, during the Family Development Sessions (FDS) co-location, Negros Oriental registered 28,531 individuals, accounting for 43.25% of the total output for Central Visayas. This demonstrates our proactive approach and effective outreach in registering our community members.

These milestones highlight our dedication to ensuring that every resident is included in the National ID system, which is vital for accessing various government services and benefits.
