Philippine Statistics Authority celebrates October 2017 as the 28th National Statistics Month (NSM)

Statistics, both its practical and theoretical aspects take center stage during the month of October as the whole country celebrates the National Statistics Month (NSM). The month-long observance is celebrated by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 647 issued on September 20, 1990 by then President Corazon C. Aquino, "Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month". The October 2017 celebration marks the 28nd year of NSM.

This year's NSM celebration embraced the theme "Facts and Figures for the Future: Statistics for Evidence-Based Decisions towards Ambisyon Natin 2040". Meanwhile, the PSA Board has issued Memorandum Circular No. 2017-12, enjoining all government agencies, academic institutions and the private sector at the national and sub-national levels to actively participate in and support in this month-long celebration.

The observance of this event aims to promote, enhance and instill nation-wide awareness and appreciation on the

importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of the society. It elicits cooperation and support from the general public in upgrading the quality and standards of statistics in the country.

This year's theme reflects the important role of reliable statistics and factual information in determining appropriate strategies for tracking our progress towards" Ambisyon Natin 2040", where all Filipinos are envisioned to enjoy a "Matatag, Maginhawa at Panatag na Buhay".

To highlight the event, Regional and Provincial Offices of Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) in Central Visayas have lined-up several activities for the celebration. Among the activities are the conduct of lecture on statistics, book display and exhibits of statistical information, mobile statistical and civil registration activities, orientation-seminars and lecture-forum on topics related to statistics. Aside from these activities, streamers bannering the theme will also be displayed.







siquijor at a glance!



Based on the 2015 Census of Population, the province of Siquijor posted a total population of 95,984 as of August 1, 2015. This is larger by 4,918 persons compared to its total population of 91,066 in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing. The increase in population count from 2010 to 2015 translated to an average annual population growth rate (PGR) 1.01 percent. This is lower than the 1.10 percent annual PGR of the province between the census years 2000 and 2010.

Among the six municipalities comprising the province of Siquijor, the municipality of Siquijor or the capital town was the most populous with a population of 26,861. San Juan was the most densely populated municipality with 335 persons per square kilometer which is 51 persons higher than the provincial population density of 284
